<i><comments></comments></i>	(1) Comparable store sales and total store sales in March 2003 were -2.0% and -3.8%, respectively in YoY terms.
	Number of customers in both comparable and total stores decreased by 5.3% and 7.2% from last year's same month.
	In March, the competitive priced and simple styled navigation model "Raku-Navi (Pioneer)" showed another month of strong sales
	also enhancing the demand of service. Meanwhile, demand of summer tires in snowing area were still very soft due to this year's
	colder than usual weather, and dragged down the overall sales figure in March.
	(2) About 40% of stores increased their sales, and 19% increased the number of customers since last year.

(3) Sales at Super Autobacs (SA) stores increased by 2.4% in comparable store basis (28 stores), and increased by 21.2% in total stores basis, both from last year's same month.
