Note 1) Approval requirement for Agenda Item No.1 is more than half of shareholders attending the meeting. Note 2) Approval requirement for Agenda Item No.2 is at least one-third of the shareholders with voting rights attending the meeting and more than two-third of them approving each proposal.

Note 3) Approval requirements for both Agenda Item No.3 and No.4 are at least one-third of the shareholders with voting rights attending the meeting and more than half of them approving each proposal.

Note 4) Numbers of voting rights indicating "FOR," "AGAINST," or "ABSTAIN" in the "Prior Exercise" are the numbers of voting rights exercised prior to the meeting by the Exercise of Voting Rights Form (including the exercise of voting rights via the Internet). Numbers of voting rights indicating "FOR," "AGAINST," or "ABSTAIN" in the "Total Voting Rights Exercised" are the sum totals of the numbers of voting rights exercised prior to the meeting and the numbers of voting rights of shareholders attending the meeting.

Note 5) The "% of FOR votes" is the proportion of the "total number of FOR votes" to the "Total Voting Rights Exercised" indicated in "2. State of Voting Rights Exercised."
