1. Status of Damage:

We have reopened one store in Oita prefecture which had been closed by the damage from the earthquake. As a result, there is no store that is still forced to close by the earthquake. We highly appreciate all the support and cooperation extended to us.

2. Impact on Performance:

The influence of this transaction on AUTOBACS SEVEN's consolidated financial performance is assumed to be low. In the event that the Company forecasts a substantial effect on its results, that information will be disclosed promptly.
